

1 all applicable law. Local Rule 183(a). Failure to comply with applicable rules and law may be
2 grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id.

3 In light of plaintiff's pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide
4 plaintiff with an opportunity to show good cause for her conduct along with a final opportunity to
5 oppose defendant's motion.

6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

7 1. Plaintiff show cause in writing within fourteen days of the date of this order as to why
8 this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution¹;

9 2. The February 17, 2017 hearing of defendant's motion to dismiss (ECF No. 3) is
10 continued to **Friday, March 17, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the United States District Court, 501 I
11 Street, Sacramento, California, in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned;

12 3. On or before **March 3, 2017**, plaintiff shall file a statement of opposition or non-
13 opposition to defendant's motion to dismiss; and

14 4. Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in a
15 recommendation that this case be dismissed.
