On August 28, 2019 the undersigned issued 18 19 Findings and Recommendations that this action be dismissed without prejudice based on 20 plaintiff's failure to comply with a court order requiring his appearance at a settlement 21 conference. ECF No. 77. Plaintiff filed two separate responses to the Findings and 22 Recommendations which the court construes as objections thereto. ECF Nos. 78, 80. So 23 construed, the court will vacate the Findings and Recommendations and permit this case to 24 proceed. Also pending before the court is plaintiff's motion to conduct a settlement conference via 25 26 correspondence. ECF No. 81. In light of plaintiff's custody status at the L.A. Men's Central Jail

period of time to engage in settlement discussions. Should the parties not settle this matter by January 6, 2020 the court will issue a discovery and scheduling order governing further proceedings in this case. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued on August 28, 2019 (ECF No. 77) are hereby vacated. 2. Plaintiff's motion to conduct a settlement conference via correspondence (ECF No. 81) is granted. The parties may engage in settlement negotiations for a period of 60 additional days from the date of this order. 3. The court will issue a discovery and scheduling order governing further proceedings in this matter should this case not settle by January 6, 2020.
