17	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis. Plaintiff appears to	
18	be seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff has consented to the jurisdiction of a	
19	magistrate judge. (ECF No. 7.)	
20	Plaintiff initiated this action by filing a document in which he requested a temporary	
21	restraining order. (ECF No. 1.) In orders filed January 17, February 24, and May 16, 2017,	
22	plaintiff was informed that he must file a complaint if he wishes to proceed with this case. In the	
23	May 16 order, plaintiff was told he would have one final opportunity to file a complaint. Plaintiff	
24	was given thirty days to do so. Plaintiff was warned that if he failed to file a complaint, this case	
25	would be dismissed.	
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Thirty days have passed and plaintiff has not filed a complaint or otherwise responded to the court's May 16 order.
