20	plaintiff, ECF No. 14, who has consented to the jurisdiction of this court. ECF No. 8. In that

21	opportunity to file an Amended Complaint in conformity to the conditions explained in the Order	
23	within 30 days of the service of the Order. Further, the Order contained notice to plaintiff that	
24	failure to comply could result in dismissal of the petition with prejudice. ECF No. 14 at 4.	
25	Plaintiff failed to file an Amended Complaint, although he did file an "Exhibit" asking for	
26	appointment of counsel.	
27	The undersigned has considered plaintiff's request for counsel. Although plaintiff's	
28	physical condition and age warrant serious consideration of the request, the undersigned sees no

1	likelihood of validity to any of the conclusionary allegations contained in the complaint which is	
2	in essence an attempt at a civil rights complaint along with a request for parole or transfer to a	
3	federal prison.
