1 WHEREAS, Plaintiff Scott Johnson (“Plaintiff”) filed his Complaint on January 24, 2017;

2 WHEREAS, Plaintiff served his Complaint on Defendant Monetary Management of
3 California, Inc. (“MMC”) on January 30, 2017;

4 WHEREAS, Plaintiff served Defendants Massie & Co. and Rick Massie by substituted
5 service on February 3, 2017 (Defendants Massie & Co., Rick Massie, and MMC hereinafter
6 collectively referred to as “Defendants”);

7 WHEREAS, through the parties’ prior stipulation [ECF No. 7], Defendants responsive
8 pleading deadline was continued to March 21, 2017;

9 WHEREAS, the parties are in the process of finalizing material terms of a settlement to
10 resolve this matter;

11 WHEREAS, the parties’ respective counsel have met and conferred and agree that, in the
12 interest of conserving the parties’ and the court’s resources, Defendants’ responsive pleading
13 deadline should be further continued by three weeks – to April 11, 2017 – to allow the parties to
14 finalize discussions regarding the material terms of the resolution.

15 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and through the
16 Parties’ respective counsel as follows:

17 Defendants’ deadline to file a responsive pleading to Plaintiff’s Complaint shall be
18 extended by three weeks to April 11, 2017.

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
ORDER
