FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On December 7, 2018, the court determined that plaintiff’s complaint was appropriate for service and directed plaintiff to submit documents for service by the United States Marshal within 30 days. Plaintiff was warned that failure to submit the required documents may result in dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution and failure to comply with court rules and orders. See Local Rule 110. To date, plaintiff has not complied. While plaintiff submitted some of the required documents on December 19, 2018, the submission is incomplete. Specifically, despite the court’s instruction to submit two copies of his complaint, plaintiff submitted copies of only portions of the complaint. To date, plaintiff has made no effort to cure his non-compliance with the court’s December 7, 2018, order.
