1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed August 3, 2022, are adopted in	
3	full;	
4	2. Defendants' motion to dismiss, ECF No. 68, is granted;	
5	3. Plaintiff's Fourth Amendment claim (first claim) is dismissed with	
6	prejudice;	
7	4. Plaintiff's due process and related claims (second claim) are dismissed	
8	with prejudice;	
9	5. Plaintiff's conspiracy claims (fourth and fifth claims) are dismissed with	
10	prejudice;	
11	6. Plaintiff's state law claims (sixth and seventh claims) are dismissed with	
12	prejudice;	
13	7 Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claims (third and eighth claims) are	
14	dismissed as against all defendants except Defendants Grinde, Bodenhamer, and Clough	
15	regarding medical needs and Defendant Burke, Cross, Valine, Lewis, Kinn, Leech, Spark,	
16	Walker, and Byers regarding excessive force;	
17	8. This action shall proceed against Defendants Grinde, Bodenhamer, Clough,	
18	Burke, Cross, Valine, Lewis, Kinn, Leech, Spark, Walker, and Byers on Plaintiff's Eighth	
19	Amendment claims (third and eighth claims) and all other defendants are dismissed; and	
20	9. Defendants shall file an answer to Plaintiff's seventh amended complaint	
21	within 30 days of the date of this order.
