ORDER

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in an action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983.<sup>1</sup> On April 28, 2017, the court denied plaintiff’s application to proceed in forma pauperis because he is a three-strikes litigant within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). ECF No. 5. Plaintiff was given 21 days within which to pay the \$400 filing fee for this action. *Id.* Plaintiff was warned that failure to pay the filing fee within 21 days would result in dismissal. *Id.* Plaintiff has not paid the filing fee or otherwise responded to the court’s order.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is dismissed.
