Petitioner took an 18 19 appeal, ECF No. 16. During the pendency of the appeal the Ninth Circuit remanded for the 20 specific purpose of determining whether petitioner's post-appeal filing, ECF No.15 "Response" 21 was an appropriate post-trial motion. In Findings and Recommendations issued November 27, 22 2017, ECF No. 21, the undersigned found that the motion could be construed as a Fed.R.Civ.P 52 motion, and recommended that it be denied. Petitioner has filed yet another document in this 23 24 case subsequent to the judgment entered on August 9, 2017, this time a Motion to Amend the 25 Petition, ECF No. 25. 1	appealed the judgment in this case. The Ninth Circuit issued specific remand instructions, and the
2	court will not go beyond those instructions to adjudicate yet another Motion to Amend. In
3	addition, the Motion is frivolous in any event, and keeps rehashing what was already adjudicated.
4	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:
5	1. The Motion to Amend, ECF No. 25 is stricken;
6	2. Any additional filings by petitioner should be directed to the Ninth Circuit Court of
7	Appeals for consideration within the context of her pending appeal.
8	3. Petitioner shall file no further pleadings in this court until the appeal is resolved, and
9	only if it is sent back for further adjudication in this court.
