This action is STAYED and REFERRED to the VDRP. 25 26 2. Within fourteen (14) days of this order, the parties shall contact the court's VDRP 27 administrator, Sujean Park, at (916) 930-4278 or SPark@caed.uscourts.gov, to start 28 the process of selecting an appropriate neutral. 1

1	3.	The parties shall carefully review and comply w	with Local Rule 271, which outlines the
2		specifications and requirements of the VDRP.	
3	4.	No later than fourteen (14) days after completion	n of the VDRP session, the parties
4		shall jointly file their VDRP Completion Report	t, consistent with Local Rule 271(o).
5	5.	Any party that objects to this referral to the VD	RP shall file its objections within seven
6		(7) days of this order. Such objections shall cle	arly outline why that party believes
7		that the action is not appropriate for referral to t	he VDRP.
