PICKETT, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with this civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. By order filed March 19, 2019, this case was referred 18 19 to the court's Post-Screening ADR (Alternative Dispute Resolution) Project and stayed for a 20 period of 120 days. ECF No. 53. That order provided defendants the opportunity to request 21 opting out of the ADR Project based on a good faith belief that a settlement conference would be 22 a waste of resources. <u>Id.</u> at 2. Defendants now request to opt out of the Post-Screening ADR 23 Project and vacate the settlement conference. ECF No. 58. Having reviewed the request, the 24 court finds good cause to grant it. 25 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 26 1. Defendants' request to opt out of the Post-Screening ADR Project (ECF No. 58) is 27 GRANTED. 28 2. The stay of this action, commencing March 19, 2019 (ECF No. 53), is LIFTED. 1

1	3. The May 20, 2019 settlement conference before Magistrate Judge Kendall Newman is
2	VACATED.
3	4. The writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum directing the Warden to produce plaintiff
4	for the settlement conference (ECF No. 57) is VACATED.
5	5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Warden of
6	California Men's Colony at P.O. Box 8101, San Luis Obispo, California 93409, and a courtesy
7	copy by fax on the Litigation Coordinator at California Men's Colony at (805) 547-7791.
8	6. By separate order, the court will set a discovery and motion schedule for this case.
