SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in this civil rights action brought under the Americans with Disabilities Act. On December 2, 2020, defendant filed a motion to opt out of the court’s alternative dispute resolution program. ECF No. 68. Plaintiff has filed a statement of non-opposition to the motion. ECF No. 69.

Good cause appearing, defendant’s motion is granted, ECF No. 68, and the January 5, 2021 settlement conference set in this case before Magistrate Judge Kendall J. Newman is vacated.²
