The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge as provided 19 by 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On March 16, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations, which were 21 served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings and 22 recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has not filed objections to the 23 findings and recommendations. 24 The court presumes that any findings of fact are correct. See Orand v. United States, 602 25 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 1979). The magistrate judge's conclusions of law are reviewed de novo. 26 See Britt v. Simi Valley Unified School Dist., 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir. 1983). Having reviewed 27 the file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by 28 the magistrate judge's analysis. 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed March 16, 2017 are adopted in full; 2. All defendants other than defendants Thomas Ferrara and Dr. Jim Lewis are dismissed; and 3. This matter is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further proceedings. DATED: May 22, 2017.
