ECF No. 1. 17 On April 6, 2017, this court issued an Order directing petitioner either to submit an appropriate 18 motion for and affidavit in support of, a request to proceed in forma pauperis with his action or to 19 submit the appropriate filing fee within 30 days of the date of the Order. ECF No. 3. In that 20 Order the Magistrate Judge also found that the petitioner had not stated a habeas claim in the filed 21 petition and gave petitioner 45 days from the date of the order to file an amended petition if he so 22 desired. Such a right to amend depended, however, upon petitioner's compliance with the 23 direction to perfect his right to proceed in forma pauperis or payment of a filing fee. 24 The order gave warning that failure to comply with the Order would result in the dismissal 25 of the action. Petitioner has not submitted either a motion for in forma pauperis status or the 26 appropriate filing fee. Nor has petitioner submitted any amended petition. 27
