ORDER


On October 29, 2020, plaintiff filed a request for reconsideration of the magistrate judge’s order filed October 7, 2020, finding discovery is closed following resolution of the pending discovery disputes. In his request, plaintiff declares under penalty of perjury that subsequent to plaintiff’s last filing and the court’s October 7, 2020 order, confidential “sources say the modified documents have something written at the top of the pages.” (ECF No. 95 at 1-2.) Because defendant failed to provide plaintiff with those pages, plaintiff states he cannot determine whether the pages have been modified or not. (ECF No. 95 at 2.) Plaintiff seeks an in camera review of his confidential information.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within fourteen days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall file with the court whatever information he has – allegedly confidential,

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1 modified documents, or otherwise. If the court finds it appropriate, the court might then order the
2 information filed under seal.
