The alleged 21 violations took place at California State Prison – Sacramento located in Sacramento County, 22 which is part of the Sacramento Division of the United States District Court for the Eastern 23 District of California. Therefore, the complaint should have been filed in the Sacramento 24 Division. 25 Pursuant to Local Rule 120(f), a civil action that has not been commenced in the proper 26 court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper court. This action will be 27 transferred to the Sacramento Division. This court will not rule on plaintiff's request to proceed in 28

1	forma pauperis, which will be addressed after the case has been transferred.
2	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
3	1. This action is transferred to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of
4	California sitting in Sacramento; and
5	2. All future filings shall refer to the new Sacramento case number assigned and shall be
6	filed at:
