23	has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. ECF No. 43.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this	
25	court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the	
26	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
27	analysis.	
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1. The findings and recommendations issued September 30, 2019 (ECF No. 42) are	
3	ADOPTED in full;	
4	2. Defendant Racklin's motion for summary judgment, filed January 28, 2019 (ECF No.	
5	38), is GRANTED;	
6	3. The screening order dated June 12, 2017 (ECF No. 7) is construed as findings and	
7	recommendations for the dismissal of all other defendants and is ADOPTED, and	
8	4. This case is CLOSED.
