On March 20, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 19.) Plaintiff has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 20.)

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The findings and recommendations filed March 20, 2018 (ECF No. 19), are adopted in full;
2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction and temporary restraining order are denied.
