17	Presently pending before the court is plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma	
18	<i>pauperis</i> pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. ¹ (ECF No. 2.) The affidavit in support of the motion	
19	indicates that plaintiff's gross wages are \$0 per month. (Id.) However, plaintiff also asserts that	
20	he has received income in the past twelve months as an employee of "Apple One," but he has not	
21	indicated what income he has received. (<u>Id.</u>)	
22	Pursuant to federal statute, a filing fee	e of \$350.00 is required to commence a civil action
23	in federal district court. 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a). In addition, a \$50.00 general administrative fee for	
24	civil cases must be paid. 28 U.S.C. § 1914(b). The court may authorize the commencement of an	
25	action "without prepayment of fees or security therefor" by a person that is unable to pay such	
26	fees or provide security therefor. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1).

1	Plaintiff has made an inadequate showing of indigency because his affidavit is incomplete.	
2	See Alexander v. Carson Adult High Sch., 9 F.3d 1448 (9th Cir. 1993); California Men's Colony	
3	v. Rowland, 939 F.2d 854, 858 (9th Cir. 1991); Stehouwer v. Hennessey, 841 F. Supp. 316, (N.D.	
4	Cal. 1994).	
5	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
6	1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is DENIED	
7	WITHOUT PREJUDICE.	
8	2. Within 28 days of the date of this order, plaintiff shall either (a) pay the applicable	
9	filing fee or (b) file an amended application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> that	
10	adequately demonstrates that plaintiff is unable to pay the filing fee. Plaintiff's	
11	failure to either pay the filing fee or file a sufficient application to proceed <i>in</i>	
12	forma pauperis by the above deadline will result in a recommendation that the	
13	action be dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).	
14	IT IS SO ORDERED.
