FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

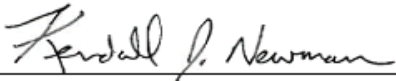
By order filed August 28, 2017, plaintiff was granted thirty days to either file an amended complaint or return the forms necessary for service. Thirty days passed and plaintiff failed to file an amended complaint or the forms necessary for service, or otherwise respond to the August 28, 2017 order.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned “Objections to Magistrate Judge’s Findings and Recommendations.” Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District

1 Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
