

1	On October 2, 2017, plaintiff filed a motion for an extension of time to file objections to
2	the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 16.) In this pleading, plaintiff states that he is
3	having difficulty obtaining medication for body pain. Plaintiff also alleges that he has been
4	"waylayed" with medical difficulties.
5	Because it appears that plaintiff intends to prosecute this action, the findings and
6	recommendations are vacated. Plaintiff is granted thirty days from the date of this order to file an
7	amended complaint. In the alternative, plaintiff may opt to proceed with the potentially colorable
8	claims against defendants Young, Rock, Nasser and Gamboa in the original complaint.
9	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
10	1. The September 13, 2017 findings and recommendations (ECF No. 15) are vacated;
11	2. Plaintiff's October 2, 2017 motion for extension of time (ECF No. 16) is denied as
12	unnecessary;
13	3. Plaintiff is granted thirty days from the date of this order to file either an amended
14	complaint or notice that he intends to proceed on the potentially colorable claims against
15	defendants Young, Rock, Nasser and Gamboa in the original complaint; if plaintiff opts to
16	proceed on his claims against defendants Young, Rock, Nasser and Gamboa, the court will send
17	plaintiff the forms necessary to effect service.
18	Failure to respond to this order will result in a recommendation of dismissal of this action.
