The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On June 1, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which 21 were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings 22 and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has filed objections to the 23 findings and recommendations. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 27 analysis. 28 ///// 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed June 1, 2018, are adopted in full; 2. The court finds plaintiff has accrued three strikes under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g) for the reasons set forth in the court's June 16, 2017 order (ECF No. 4); 3. The court finds plaintiff has failed to demonstrate that, at the time he filed his complaint, he was in imminent danger of serious physical injury, for the reasons set forth in the July 6, 2017 order (ECF No. 7); 4. The court denies plaintiff's motion to proceed IFP (ECF No. 6); and 5. If plaintiff wishes to proceed with this action, within fourteen days of the date of this order, he must pay the full filing fee of \$400.
