

41(a)(1)(A)(i). However, defendants may choose to stipulate to dismissal without prejudice pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Should defendants decline to stipulate as such, the court may dismiss this action based upon plaintiff's request, "on terms that the court considers proper." Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2). Accordingly, it is ORDERED that no later than June 28, 2017, defendants shall file and serve a document stipulating to dismissal of this action without prejudice pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), or otherwise respond to plaintiff's motion.
