

1 short procedural history; (d) an analysis of the risk of liability, including a discussion of the
2 efforts made to investigate the allegations; and (e) a discussion of the efforts that have been made
3 to settle the case.

4 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5 1. This action is stayed for 120 days to allow the parties an opportunity to settle their
6 dispute prior to trial. Except as provided herein or by subsequent court order, no other pleadings
7 or other documents may be filed in this case during the stay of this action.

8 2. Within thirty days from the date of this order, the assigned Deputy Attorney General
9 shall contact this court's Courtroom Deputy, Judy Streeter, at (916) 930-4004, to schedule the
10 settlement conference.

11 3. At least seven days prior to the settlement conference, each party shall submit a
12 confidential settlement conference statement, as described above, to the judge assigned for
13 settlement.

14 4. If a settlement is reached at any point during the stay of this action, the parties shall file
15 a Notice of Settlement in accordance with Local Rule 160.

16 5. The parties remain obligated to keep the court informed of their current address at all
17 times during the stay and while the action is pending. Any change of address must be reported
18 promptly to the court in a separate document captioned for this case and entitled "Notice of
19 Change of Address." See L.R. 182(f).
