The thirty day period has now expired, and 20 plaintiff has not responded to the court's order and has not filed the required affidavit or paid the 21 filing fee. 22 IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 23 24 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days 25 after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written 26 objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any response to the 27

objections shall be filed and served within fourteen days after service of the objections. The
