court further finds that an interlocutory appeal of this court's 1 order on summary judgment (Docket No. 56) would not materially 2 3 advance the ultimate termination of this litigation nor would it avoid protracted and expensive litigation. See 28 U.S.C. § 4 1292(b); U.S. Rubber Co. v. Wright, 359 F.2d 784, 785 (9th Cir. 5 6 1966). 7 Accordingly, plaintiffs' Motion for Entry of Final Judgment, Or, In the Alternative, Motion for Certification of an 8 9 Interlocutory Appeal (Docket No. 72) is DENIED. Before August 5, 2019, plaintiffs shall (1) request and 10 11 receive an entry of default from the Clerk of Court as to 12 defendants Perri Electric Inc. Profit Sharing Plan and Perri Electric Inc. Profit Sharing Trust Fund and move for default 13 14 judgment as to these defendants **OR** (2) enter into a stipulation 15 with an attorney representing Perri Electric Inc. Profit Sharing 16 Plan and Perri Electric Inc. Profit Sharing Trust Fund that 17 resolves plaintiffs' claims against those defendants. 18

This matter is set for further status conference on August 5, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 5.
