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18	By an order issued April 9, 2018, plaintiff was ordered to pay the \$400.00 filing fee in	
19	compliance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a), 1914 (Judicial Conference Schedule of Fees, No. 14)	
20	within thirty days. At that time, plaintiff was also cautioned that failure to do so would result in a	
21	recommendation that this action be dismissed. The thirty day period has now expired, and	
22	plaintiff has not responded to the court's order and has not paid the required fee.	
23	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be DISMISSED without	
24	prejudice.	
25	These findings and recommendations	are submitted to the United States District Judge

27	after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections	
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1	with the court. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings
2	and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified
3	time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153
4	(9th Cir. 1991).
