25 26	$\frac{1}{1}$ The court has disposed of approximately 200 cases filed by plaintiff since 2004. As plaintiff		
27	knows well by now, he has "struck out" under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). Being a "three strikes" litigant, plaintiff may only proceed in forma pauperis if he alleges he is under imminent danger of		
28	serious physical injury in his pleadings. The allegations in plaintiff's complaint do not amount to a showing of imminent danger of serious physical injury.		
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff is granted fourteen days within	
2	which to pay the \$400 filing fee for this action. Failure to pay the filing fee within fourteen days	
3	will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed.
