**ORDER & WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS  
AD TESTIFICANDUM**

Christopher Lipsey, Jr., CDCR # F-18039, a necessary and material witness in a settlement conference in this case on November 17, 2020, is confined in Kern Valley State Prison (KVSP), in the custody of the Warden.
