ORDER AFTER HEARING

2 responsive to plaintiff's Requests for Production of Documents. Defendant shall produce all
3 responsive emails by May 23, 2018.²

4 4. In regards to all remaining discovery requests at issue, the parties shall promptly meet
5 and confer, as detailed on the record.
