



1 sanctions. Finally, Local Rule 110 provides that failure to comply with the Local Rules “may be  
2 grounds for imposition of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the  
3 inherent power of the Court.”

4 In order to allow plaintiff adequate time to respond to the motion to dismiss, the court will  
5 continue the motion hearing. The hearing will now take place on October 4, 2017 at 10 a.m. At  
6 this hearing the court will address the motion to dismiss as well as discuss some of the basic  
7 aspects of appearing in federal court as a self-represented litigant. Plaintiff has indicated that she  
8 is unsure of what to do with the consent or decline magistrate jurisdiction form. The court will  
9 discuss the difference between magistrate judges and district court judges at the hearing on  
10 defendant’s motion to dismiss.

11 Finally, plaintiff indicates that she is seeking attorney representation. The court notes that  
12 until representation is secured, plaintiff is required to adhere to all deadlines and follow the  
13 Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and this Court’s Local Rules, located at

16 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 17 1. The motion hearing date of September 27, 2017 is CONTINUED to October, 4,  
18 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom No. 4;
- 19 2. Plaintiff shall file an opposition – or a Statement of Non-Opposition – to the  
20 motion, no later than September 20, 2017. Failure to file an opposition or to  
21 appear at the hearing will be deemed as a statement of non-opposition and shall  
22 result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule  
23 of Civil Procedure 41(b); and
- 24 3. The Clerk of Court shall serve upon plaintiff defendant’s motion to dismiss,  
25 located at ECF No. 4.
