The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 18 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On September 7, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on Plaintiff and which contained notice to Plaintiff that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has not filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 23 24 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY 25 26 ORDERED that: 27 1. The findings and recommendations filed September 7, 2018, are adopted in full; and 28 2. This action shall proceed against Sergeant Speers on an Eighth Amendment conditions 1

of confinement claim and against Warden Spearman and Sergeant Speers on a First Amendment Free Exercise claim and a Fourteenth Amendment Equal Protection claim. All other claims and defendants are dismissed. Dated: October 16, 2018 Troy L. Nunley United States District Judge
