In this order, the undersigned found that plaintiff's claims against 20 defendants Lassen County and Bustamante were barred by the doctrines of res judicata and 21 collateral estoppel. For the reasons stated in that order, the undersigned herein recommends 22 dismissal of defendants Lassen County and Bustamante. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall appoint a 23 24 district judge to this action; and IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendants Lassen County and Bustamante be 25 26 dismissed. 27 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge

assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days
