## ORDER & WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS AD TESTIFICANDUM

- 4. Counsel for defendant, the assigned Deputy Attorney General, shall confirm with the prison no less than two days prior to the settlement conference that the prison's video-conference equipment will connect to the court's system.
