ORDER

Defendant has filed a motion asking the court to extend the dispositive motion deadline in this action. ECF No. 43. The initial scheduling order provided that all pretrial motions were due on or before September 11, 2020. ECF No. 29. On August 25, 2020, the undersigned, following a motion for an extension of discovery, extended the deadline by 30 days. ECF No. 42. In the instant motion, defendant states that due to information presented during plaintiff's deposition, defendant now needs to request and review previously unreviewed medical records. ECF No. 43 at 1-2. Defendant requests an additional thirty days to review the records and provide plaintiff with a copy. Id.
