ORDER

Plaintiff is a pretrial detainee, recently returned to the Butte County Jail.¹ On November 21, 2017, the undersigned recommended that this action be dismissed because plaintiff failed to timely file an amended complaint. On November 22, 2017, plaintiff’s motion for extension of time in which to file an amended complaint was entered on the docket. Plaintiff’s motion was signed on November 15, 2017. Therefore, plaintiff’s motion was timely. Good cause appearing, plaintiff’s motion for extension of time to file an amended complaint is granted, and the findings and recommendations are vacated.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations (ECF No. 7) are vacated;


