(ECF No. 38.) The undersigned granted 20 plaintiff thirty days to file a second amended complaint. (Id.) Over thirty days have passed from 21 March 12, 2019, and plaintiff did not file a second amended complaint. 22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). 23 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 25 26 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections 27 with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned

"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that
