On 17 December 1, 2020, the court directed defendants to file a document stipulating to dismissal of this 18 action without prejudice, or otherwise respond to plaintiff's requests for voluntary dismissal. 19 ECF No. 63. Defendants timely filed an opposition to plaintiff's requests, arguing that any 20 dismissal of this action should be with prejudice. ECF No. 64. Alternatively, defendants argue 21 that should this action be dismissed without prejudice, plaintiff should be required to reimburse 22 them the reasonable expenses they incurred in seeking to compel discovery. *Id.* at 5. 23 Plaintiff is granted fourteen days to file a reply to defendants' opposition. Thereafter, 24 plaintiff's requests for voluntary dismissal with stand submitted for decision. 25
