


1 court is legally proper, he may file a motion to remand within thirty days of this order's entry.¹
2 That motion should cite legal authority which supports his arguments for remand.

28 made within thirty days of the filing of the notice of removal. See 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c). To the
extent plaintiff's remand arguments are not based on a lack of subject matter jurisdiction, the
court will extend the deadline and grant him thirty days from the date of this order's entry.
