1. The Petition (ECF No. 26) is GRANTED and the compromise is approved.
The minor Plaintiffs shall receive the following by way of settlement:
 \$15,140 to A.Z.; and
 \$15,140 to A.Z.
2. Within 72 hours of receipt of a check payable to the order of the Petitioner as trustee for the respective Claimants, Guardian Ad Litem Alicia Zender shall deposit the checks for the minor children in blocked accounts at a federally insured bank or credit union.
3. Guardian Ad Litem Alicia Zender must deliver to each depository at the time of deposit a copy of this order.
4. No withdrawals of principal or interest may be made from the blocked accounts without a written order under this case name and number, signed by a judge, and bearing the seal of this Court, until the respective minors attain the age of 18 years. When the respective minor attains the age of 18 years, the depository, without further order of this Court, is authorized and directed to pay by check or draft directly to the former minor, upon proper demand, all moneys including interest deposited under this order. The money on deposit is not subject to escheat. The blocked accounts in this matter are to be opened solely for the benefit of minor Plaintiffs in this case and such funds placed, therein, cannot be accessed by anybody other than the respective minor Plaintiffs upon reaching the age of majority. The parents/guardian ad litem shall have no right to access any of the funds in such blocked account for any reason.
5. Guardian Ad Litem Alicia Zender is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents reasonably necessary to carry out the terms of the settlement.
