17	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with an action	
18	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge	
19	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
20	On March 14, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein	
21	which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the	
22	findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 14.) Plaintiff has	
23	not filed objections to the findings and recommendations. However, plaintiff has filed a response	
24	to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 21.)	
25	The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be	
26	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY	
27	ORDERED that:	
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1	1. The findings and recommendations filed March 14, 2018 (ECF No. 14), are adopted in
2	full;
3	2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction (ECF No. 7) is denied;
4	3. Plaintiff's motion for class certification (ECF No. 10) is denied; and
5	4. The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is dismissed as a
6	defendant.
