4. Within fourteen (14) days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall submit to the Jnited States Marshal a completed summons, a completed USM-285 form, sufficient copies of he summons and complaint for service of process in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil rocedure 4(i), and sufficient copies of the Scheduling Order and Order re Consent or Request for Reassignment issued in this case. - 5. Within five (5) days after submitting the necessary documents to the United States Marshal for service or process, plaintiff shall file in this court a declaration stating the date on which the documents were submitted to the United States Marshal. Failure to file a timely eclaration may result in an order imposing appropriate sanctions.
- 6. The United States Marshal is directed to serve process and copies of the undersigned's cheduling Order and Order re Consent or Request for Reassignment without prepayment of osts not later than sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Service of process shall be completed by delivering all necessary documents to the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of California and by sending copies of the summons, complaint and court orders by registered or certified mail to the Attorney General of the United States at Washington, D.C. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(i)(1)(A) & (B).
