21	above-captioned currency ("defendant currency"), based on its involvement in federal drug law

23	with Dusenbery v. United States, 534 U.S. 161, 168 (2002) and the applicable statutory authority.	
24	Additionally, public notice on the official internet government forfeiture site, <u>www.forfeiture.gov</u> , began	
25	on October 18, 2017, and ran for thirty consecutive days, as required by Rule G(4)(a)(iv)(C) of	
26	Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions. A Declaration of	
27	Publication was filed on November 17, 2017.

Good Cause 1 The United States has provided notice to all potential claimants pursuant to law. Specifically, 2 the United States served a copy of the complaint documents to potential claimant Stacey Cheatham via 3 certified and first class mail as well as personal service, but he has not filed a claim. At this point, the 4 5 time to file a claim and enter the case has expired. Accordingly, the United States requested a Clerk's Default against Stacey Cheatham and the 6 Court entered a Clerk's Certificate of Entry of Default on December 21, 2017. The United States will 7 file a motion for default judgment and final judgment of forfeiture with the Court and such filings, 8 if/when granted, would terminate the case.
