FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

By order filed May 27, 2020, plaintiff was ordered to pay the filing fee within thirty days and was cautioned that failure to do so would result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed. ECF No. 20. The thirty-day period has now expired, and plaintiff has not responded to the court’s order or paid the required fees.


Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice for failure to pay the filing fee.

These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections with the court. Such a document should be captioned “Objections to Magistrate Judge’s Findings and Recommendations.” Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified
