The matter was referred to 18 19 a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 Petitioner has filed a request for a status update in this case. ECF No. 19. The court 21 confirms that the case has been fully briefed and is submitted for decision. The disposition of 22 habeas matters is frequently delayed in this court due to heavy caseloads and a shortage of 23 jurists.1 //// 24 25 <sup>1</sup> The Eastern District of California carries one of the largest and most heavily weighted caseloads in the nation. See Office of the Clerk, United States District Court, Eastern District of 26 California, 2021 Annual Report, "Workload Statistics," p. 19 (2021) ("[O]ur weighted caseload far exceeds the national average . . . ranking us ninth in the nation and first in the Ninth Circuit."). 27 This problem is dramatically compounded by the need for additional judgeships commensurate 28 with the caseloads and population of the district. See id. 1
