Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

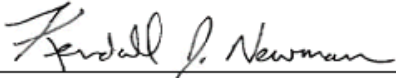
1. Within 21 days of this order, plaintiff shall show cause in writing why plaintiff should not be sanctioned for failure to comply with the court’s scheduling order.
