The publication is to include the following: 6 (1) The Court and case number of the action; 7 (2) The date of the seizure/posting; 8 (3) The identity and/or description of the property seized/posted; 9 The name and address of the attorney for the United States; (4) 10 A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or claiming an (5) 11 interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court and served on the attorney for 12 the United States no later than 60 days after the first day of publication on the official internet 13 government forfeiture site; and 14 A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under Rule 12 of the 15 (6) Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed.
