1	2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send petitioner a copy of the in forma pauperis
2	form used by this District;
3	3. Respondent is directed to file a response to petitioner's habeas petition within sixty
4	days from the date of this order. See Rule 4, 28 U.S.C. foll. § 2254. An answer shall be
5	accompanied by all transcripts and other documents relevant to the issues presented in the
6	petition. See Rule 5, 28 U.S.C. foll. § 2254;
7	4. If the response to the habeas petition is an answer, petitioner's reply, if any, shall be
8	filed and served within thirty days after service of the answer;
9	5. If the response to the habeas petition is a motion, petitioner's opposition or statement
10	of non-opposition to the motion shall be filed and served within thirty days after service of the
11	motion, and respondent's reply, if any, shall be filed and served within fourteen days thereafter;
12	and
13	6. The Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this order, the form Consent to Proceed
14	Before a United States Magistrate Judge, and a copy of the petition for writ of habeas corpus
15	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 on Tami Krenzin, Supervising Deputy Attorney General.
