

1 In violation of the court's order, respondent failed to appear despite having actual notice of the
2 scheduled judgment debtor examination.²

3 In light of respondent's failure to appear, it is hereby ORDERED that:

4 1. The judgment debtor examination is continued to December 19, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., in
5 Courtroom No. 8.

6 2. Respondent shall appear before the court on December 19, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., in
7 Courtroom No. 8, to show cause why sanctions should not be imposed for its failure to appear at
8 the November 28, 2018 judgment debtor examination, including the payment of the fees of the
9 court reporter and attorney's fees incurred as a result of that failure to appear, as set forth in the
10 declaration filed by petitioner's counsel. *See* ECF No. 88.

11 3. Respondent is admonished that failure to comply with this order will result in the
12 imposition of further sanctions and an order to show cause in re contempt.
