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18	On January 1, 2018, the undersigned granted plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma	
19	pauperis and ordered plaintiff to submit to the United States Marshal the documents necessary for	
20	service of process. (ECF No. 3.) Plaintiff was also ordered to file in this court a declaration	
21	stating the date on which the documents were submitted to the United States Marshal within five	
22	days after submitting those documents.	
23	Despite the considerable passage of time, plaintiff has not filed a declaration stating the	
24	date on which the documents necessary for service were submitted to the United States Marshall	
25	and the defendant has not appeared in this action. Plaintiff is advised that Rule 4(m) of the	
26	Federal Rules of Civil Procedure provides that a defendant must be dismissed if service of the	
27	summons and complaint is not accomplished on the defendant within 90 days after the complaint	
28	was filed.	1
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff shall show cause in writing within	
2	twenty-one days why this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. ¹ Failure to file a	
3	timely response may result in the dismissal of this action.
